## THE FOLLOWING IS VERY IMPORTANT:

- ★ There are no drops after February 3rd. Starting February 4th, to leave a class you must **withdraw** online in Banner. **February 3rd** is the last day to leave a class without financial penalty. Your refund percentages, based on date of withdrawal, are available on the Student Accounts [Refunds and Financial Liability](#) webpage.
- ★ The process to late add a class is done **electronically**; instructions for this process can be found [here](#).

## Other Important Reminders:

### Registrar’s Office

- Verify your schedule in [Banner \(View/Print schedule\)](#) to make sure instructors or class locations haven’t changed.
- Use [Schedule Planner](#) to simplify and decrease the amount of time spent in planning your schedule.
- Resolve [registration add error messages here](#) (these errors prevent you from registering for a course)
- If you are on a [waitlist](#) for a course, check the schedule to see if another section has seats available. It’s always a best practice to secure a seat in a course as soon as possible; do not wait until the start of the semester.

### Financial Aid Information

- [Review financial aid awards](#) in Banner and check the “Eligibility” section for requirements/missing documents.
- Request a [Textbook Deferment](#) online via Banner or in-person (FAO or SAO) from **1/10/19 – 2/6/19**.
- Complete the [2019-2020 FAFSA](#) (using 2017 federal income tax data) as soon as possible for next fall and spring.
- Review the [Spring Aid Disbursement and Refund Schedule](#)

### Student Accounts Office

- Electronic bills (eBills) are the exclusive billing method for Buffalo State student account balances. E-billing notifications will be sent to your Buffalo State student email account.
- Students have ability to grant parents or others access to view/ pay their e-bill by establishing an “Authorized Payer” account in QuikPAY.
- Enroll in [direct deposit](#) if you are expecting a refund from financial aid funds
