- 1. Obtain signature approvals in both Part 1 (chair of the course equivalent, e.g.: Math course = Math Chair) and Part 2 (Chair of your Major). Please return the original to the Registrar's Office and keep a copy for your records.
- 2. All transfer credit hour policies published in the current college catalog will apply. Upon completion of the course have an official copy of your transcript from the school you attended sent to Buffalo State, 1300 Elmwood Avenue, Buffalo, N.Y. 14222 ATTN: Off Campus Study Coordinator, Registrar's Office. Credit hours will be posted to Degree Works and your official Buffalo State transcript by the Registrar's Office upon receipt of your official transcript.
- 3. Only credit hours are transferable. Grades, quality point and cumulative averages do not transfer. A maximum of 90 credit hours may be transferred from other accredited institutions, no more than 66 credit hours of which may be transferred from two-year degree programs.
- 4. You can repeat a Buffalo State course for which you earned a grade of C- or less by taking it at another college. <u>A minimum grade of C is required for transfer credit hours to be applied as a repeated course.</u> Upon transfer of the repeated course, the Buffalo State course <u>grade</u> and credit hours will be excluded.
- 5. Courses taken at institutions using the quarter hour system are transferred back to Buffalo State at 2/3 semester hour for each quarter hour. For example: 3 quarter hours = 2 semester hours. These quarter hour courses cannot be used to repeat a course at Buffalo State.
- 6. If this form is completed after courses are taken at another institution, there is no guarantee that the transfer credit will be applied.
